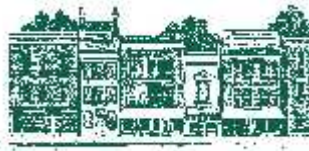

**“Pedaling Art”
2014 Summer Art Exhibit
Artist Guidelines**

1. The Downtown Auburn Business Association (DABA) will provide to the artist one standard 26 inch Beach Cruiser Bicycle.
2. Each artist will provide his/her own materials (paint, brushes, etc.) to complete entry.
3. Artistic style of each entry will be left to the discretion of each artist, but a proposed theme must be submitted with completed application.
4. Artist will not be allowed to alter the structural integrity of the bicycle by removing or adding material. This is an interactive exhibit so bicycles must remain in a state in which they can be sat on and pedaled in place.
5. Weather resistant paints/materials must be used on bicycle.
6. Each entry will be sold at auction at no reserve in September. The proceeds from each sale will be split (50/50) between each respective artist and DABA.
7. All entries must be titled.
8. All entries must be family friendly.
9. Location for each entry will determined by representatives from the Ft. Wayne Museum of Art and members of the DABA Art Committee. All bicycles will be located in the Downtown Auburn Business District.
11. The Downtown Auburn Business Association (DABA) and/or the DABA Art Committee members reserve the right to refuse the acceptance of any work deemed inappropriate and/or not suitable for family viewing. If deemed inappropriate, artist agrees to reimburse DABA for all materials cost associated with the purchase of the bicycle.
12. The artist agrees to indemnify and to hold harmless the City of Auburn, the Downtown Auburn Business Association, and the DABA Art Committee members, their officers, employees, and agents from any and all claims, actions, judgments, losses, costs, (including reasonable attorney fees), and damages whatsoever; including claims arising by reason of accident, injury, or death caused to persons or property of any kind, arising out of, in connection with or incidental to the “Pedaling Art” Exhibit. By signing below, I certify I have read this document, and agree to abide by the committee’s regulations contained in the guidelines and as decided by the committee, and know that failure to do so may result in my being asked to withdraw from the exhibit.
13. Bicycles are to be completed by June 7, 2014. By signing the application and taking possession of the bicycle, artist is contracted to complete the work by the due date listed above. Failure to do so will result in artist reimbursing DABA for all materials cost associated with the purchase of the bicycle.
